

Bethany Lutheran Church has received \$39, 867.29 from the Marvin E. Simonsen Estate. The bequest was that money be used for youth activities and scholarships. The Youth board makes the following 3 recommendations for the use of these monies.

The Marvin E. Simonsen Education Scholarship.

We recommend that \$14,000 be used for higher education scholarships in the amount of \$200 each. This would go to applicants that are active members of Bethany Lutheran Church, who plan to attend class full time, and take at least 12 credits per semester. It is a one-time scholarship from the church. Applications will be available in the church office and are due back by the 15th of April of the year. This money will be tracked in its own line on the fund balance report- Marvin E. Simonsen Scholarship and will run until money runs out.

The Simonsen Confirmation Camp Scholarship

We recommend that \$14,000 be used towards confirmation camp. This scholarship would pay \$200 towards each confirmation student's camp fee at the time they attend camp as a confirmation class. There is no application necessary. The money will be used when paying the deposit to the camp. The Youth Board will oversee this and the money will be tracked as a line item on the fund balance report- the Simonsen Confirmation Camp Scholarship. This will continue until the money runs out.

Youth Activities and Missions

The remainder of the money will be put in the Youth Fund and tracked. It will be used for special activities and outings to be determined by the Youth Board. The beginning balance is \$11, 867.29.

Bethany has had some unexpected expenses since the beginning of the year. Our church had elevator repairs, the furnace had needed repairs, increased utility expenses, increased insurance expenses, etc. Because of the additional expenses, Bethany has fallen behind in our regular budget giving.

Church leaders sometimes shy away from discussing financial stewardship in the church. It can be uncomfortable to talk about finances openly.

The stewardship of giving is more than a response to the generosity of God. The foundational principle of stewardship is that God is the owner of all, and we are simply passing on a portion of what He entrusts to us. We are stewards of talents, gifts, time and treasure given to us by God.

Stewardship giving does not buy happiness, or love, or a return on our investment. The motive for giving a gift is not the expectation of getting something back. Stewardship giving is a response to the generosity of God. We give because God has first given to us. When we give to Bethany, we are passing on a portion of what God has given us.

Pray for Bethany as we strive to "Catch-Up" in our giving toward budget needs, special ministries and worship and Sunday School attendance.




